With that said, here are the ten excuses I hear all the time as a dating coach, and my responses to them.

Excuse #1: “But Attraction Isn’t Everything”

The most common excuse that I hear from my readers is “Marius...you have some cool tips, but relationships aren't all about attraction.” These readers will downplay the role of attraction and blame their failure on external factors. They will also quickly point out the fact that a relationship needs to have more than just attraction to work in the long run.

I often shake my head in amazement when I receive such messages because every almost every single time I hear this excuse, I am being misunderstood or misquoted out of context. One thing I have learned over the years is that many people will quickly pick out what *bugs them the most* and use that as a point of criticism while ignoring the rest.

Here is an extreme example: Years ago, I received a long letter from a reader who demanded a refund for my *Smart Dating Course* because he hated the fact that I told my readers to wear nice shoes on a date. Although it's just one minor point (maybe two sentences) out of the couple hundred of pages I have in my book, the man was angry enough to pick it out and write a two-page letter rebutting it. Crazy, eh? But if you think about it, this man is really no

different than readers who refuse to learn anything because they don't want to believe that attraction *does* play an important role in relationships. So they focus on that and ignore everything else that I teach.

Anyone who has studied my works in depth will know that although I consider attraction to be very important, it is only one of the three pillars of what I teach. I also focus on communication and character. But guess what? Because communication and character are not as “sexy” as attraction, many people just skim over them.

Here is my opinion. **Attraction IS important, and it closely interacts with character and communication to determine the outcome of a relationship.** Here are some examples of how it relates to everything:

- A man and a woman have some religious differences. If they are attracted “enough” to each other, they will have a higher chance of working things out. But the attraction has to be there or they won't bother to work on the relationship. (Diagnosis: I would tell the client to focus on the attraction while ironing out the religious differences through communication skills.)
- A man and a woman are not right for each other (they are both a little crazy) but they are still together because of high attraction. As a result, there's a lot of drama *and* abuse in their relationship. In this case, attraction is holding a bad relationship together. (Diagnosis: This is when I would tell the client to IGNORE the attraction and break up a.s.a.p.)
- A couple has been together for twenty years but the marriage is dying. There's very little communication. (Diagnosis: This is when I would tell the client to work on the attraction first and THEN work on the communication because without at least a bit of attraction, working on the communication will actually push the other party away.)

Rather than just discrediting attraction because it doesn't sound politically correct, think about how to use it to make relationships better!

Excuse #2: “I Don't Want To Play Mindgames”

As you can probably guess, a criticism that I often get from my readers is that I tell people to “play mindgames.”

Nothing can be further from the truth.

Things such as flirting, teasing, and acting like a challenge should not be considered as game-playing. They are absolutely necessary in order to spark attraction or to maintain a relationship. As I always say, the couple that plays is the couple that stays.

So how are my techniques different than playing manipulative mind games?

And what are the differences between sparking attraction and playing manipulative mind games?

Let me show you giving you a couple of examples.

- 1) I think it is okay to act a bit mysterious at the beginning when you first meet a woman, but I don't think it is okay to act evasive or put on a charade for an extended period of time.

Bottom line: Not wearing your heart on your sleeve is a technique I teach. Always keeping things from your partner is a kind of manipulation I do *not* recommend.

- 2) I think it is okay to tell a few cool stories or dress up in nice clothes to raise your social proof, but I don't think

it is not okay to lie about your job or your family background.

Bottom line: Presenting yourself well to create a first good impression is something I recommend, lying isn't.

- 3) I think it is okay to pull back and use the silent treatment to "freak out" a misbehaving girlfriend, but I don't think it is okay to stop a woman from seeing her friends as a way of controlling her. One is called being assertive, the other, pure abuse and manipulation!

Bottom line: Being assertive is okay. Being abusive isn't.

- 4) I think it is okay to use the hot/cold technique from my "Smart Relationships Course" to bring back the chemistry in a dying relationship, but I would come after you personally if you tried to use it to manipulate a woman by brainwashing her.

Bottom line: Sparking attraction is good. Using negativity to control someone isn't.

- 5) I think it is okay to use my "compliment-command" technique to break down a bitch shield, but I think it is wrong to use flattery to make an insecure woman dependent on you.

Bottom line: Acting like a challenge is okay. Mind control isn't.

Here's what I recommend: Learn my techniques, and trust your good character to only put them to good use!

Excuse #3: “But I Can’t...”

Every week I hear excuses such as:

“I can’t flirt...”

“I can’t do this...”

“I can’t approach women...”

But you know what I always say?

There is no “I can’t”, just “I won’t”!

For example, if you email me and say “I can’t flirt”, you don’t actually mean you’re physically incapable of flirting. What you REALLY mean is that you “won’t” or “don’t” want to flirt. (By the way, “I don’t know how to flirt” is not a valid excuse because if you were determined, you could learn and practice till you do. But if you don’t want to learn how to flirt, then once again, it’s a “don’t” problem.)

And if you INSIST that you “can’t” flirt, then chances are, there are some beliefs in your mind that are stopping you from flirting. For example, you may believe that it is “wrong” or even “immoral”. So once again, it is because you “won’t”, not because you “can’t”.

The same thing applies to approaching women. It’s not that you can’t approach women. It’s just that you aren’t willing to deal with the potential rejection.

Here’s what I want you to do whenever you tell yourself that you “cannot” do something.

- 1) Think about what it is that you “can’t” do.
- 2) Rephrase it as “I won’t” in order to see how you REALLY feel about the matter.

- 3) Think about what you “need” to do in order to prepare yourself to do what you thought you couldn’t do.
- 4) Think about the potential rewards.
- 5) See if the rewards outweigh the “work” or pain required.
- 6) Ask yourself if you still “won’t” do it. Think long term.

You’ll quickly see how often your mind will come up with different bullsh** excuses just so you can stay within your comfort zone!

Excuse #4: “I Want A Relationship...”

Another common excuse that I hear is, “Marius, but I don’t want to use your dating techniques because I am interested in a relationship...”

Here’s what I always write back:

Ugh...what makes you think that you can’t have a relationship if you use my techniques?

A relationship should be a natural progression of casual dating. You cannot expect to get into a serious relationship with a woman without proper attraction and communication. So even if you want a relationship, you need to spark attraction and take things slowly. If you act like you want to get married while you’re still on your first date, you’re just going to push the woman away!

So go ahead and use my stuff raise the attraction as high as you can. It will NOT ruin your chances for a relationship. However, good luck trying to start a relationship without any attraction!

Excuse #5: “Life Isn’t Fair...”

From time to time, I hear complaints about how life isn’t fair. I hear about how it is unfair that a woman cannot see how a certain guy is the better guy for her. I hear about how it is unfair that women are more attracted to guys with more money and social status...

You know what I think? I think in most cases, these guys automatically think life is unfair when something is not designed for *their* benefits.

There is nothing unfair about women being attracted to men that have money or power. There is also nothing unfair about women being attracted to men with good dating skills. It’s just part of life.

Is it unfair to the fat chicks out there that most guys would be attracted to a woman who is hot, attractive, and charming? Don’t fat chicks need loving too? Is it unfair to gay men that you are attracted to women, not guys? (Or vice versa?)

You can’t control some of the cards that nature has given you. Instead of complaining about your hand, think about how you can do *your* best with it. If you have good looks, use it. If you don’t, then simply focus on other things.

It’s really as simple as that.

Focus on what you can change, and you will automatically have more success than most people out there – including many that are more genetically gifted than you are.

Excuse #6: “I Want To Be Myself”

Quite often, a reader will email me and tell me how they aren't going to follow any of my tips because a man “should be himself.”

I agree, but with a slight twist. Not only do I think a man should be himself, I think a man should be his *best* self.

Let's say you totally suck at bowling. Does that define your identity? Should you be known as the guy who sucks at bowling? And let's say, for argument's sake, that somehow you train with a good bowling coach and become a better bowler, will you suddenly become someone different? Will you stop being yourself?

Of course not! You will still be yourself. You will also be better at bowling, but you will still be yourself.

Or let's say you are arrogant by nature and offend a lot of people by being too blunt. If you become more tact and diplomatic, will that suddenly make you a bad person?

Dating is no different. Just because you're learning how to treat women better, you aren't going to become someone fake or someone who's a scumbag. You will still be 100% yourself – just a better self!

Excuse #7: “I Lack...”

Another common excuse that I get all the time is the “But I am <insert excuse here>...” excuse.

Examples:

“I am too short to attract women.”

“Women don't like bald men.”

“White women only want to date white men.”

And so on...

You will quickly see they are just self-limiting beliefs if you ask yourself this question:

“So is there not a single man in the world with a similar problem who isn’t dating an attractive woman?”

Here are some examples:

- 1) *“Is there not a single bald man in this world who is dating a good woman?”*
- 2) *“Is there not a single guy in the world who is dating a taller woman?”*
- 3) *“Is there not a single black man in your town who is dating a white woman?”*
- 4) *“Is there not a single guy in a wheelchair who is happily married?”*

Now think about WHY these guys are having more successful than you. (Hint: It’s not because of luck.) Think about what they are doing DIFFERENT than you...and then do the same!

Excuse #8: “But What You Suggest Doesn’t Feel Right...”

Of course, another excuse that I get all the time is that my techniques or recommended courses of actions don’t always feel nature or “right.”

For example, many guys and women who write me for relationship advice are afraid that if they do not go after their partners or crushes constantly, something bad will happen. Some even think that if they maintain any sort of emotional distance, their crushes or mates will think they are not interested and give up. So they chase and chase or push and push until they push their crushes or loved ones away.

In my opinion, this is the biggest irony of all: When it comes to dating and relationships, people often make things worse because they are trying to make things better. They are constantly thinking things such as:

"What if she forgets me if I don't call her back right away?"

"But I want her to be happy, and I know she will be happy if I call her again!!!"

"If I don't ask her out again now, another guy might beat me to it."

"If I don't show her how much I still love her, she will start seeing that other guy."

"If I don't go to the prom with her, she may find another date, and then I won't have another chance..."

And as a result, they do things such as:

- Coming on too strong.
- Acting too needy.
- Being pushy.

- Being annoying instead of persistent.
- Spending money on gifts and flowers.
(Which can kill attraction in some cases.)
- "Confessing" their love. (Bad idea!)

If you're a student of my "Smart Dating System", you should know that these actions will quickly push a woman (or man) away.

As I always say, just because something feels good to you doesn't mean it will raise a woman's attraction towards you. So be careful, and use advice that can actually give you results rather than just following your instincts!

Excuse #9: "I Think My Case Is Special"

Of course, many readers tell me I have to treat their cases differently because they are different.

Ugh...okay...

Seriously, to this day I have not found a single case that I cannot break down and explain using my *Smart Dating Model*, and I have worked with thousands of clients in the past eight years.

As humans, we have the tendency to pick out differences instead of seeing the similarities. We categorize and then focus on the differences. That's how our brains work. But if you want success, you need to look at the common recurring patterns in the world around you and see how they apply to YOUR life.

Here's a little example. Imagine one of your female friends is going out with a chronic liar and gambler. Every week, she sobs on the phone and tells you all about the drama she is going through.

To her, her case is probably too "special" and "unique" for any relationship book out there. But to you, you just think she's one of the many women who have fallen for the wrong man. At the end of the day, any experienced relationship coach can reduce her whole case into one short little paragraph and tell her what's probably going to happen to her relationship in the future based on similar cases they have worked on in the past. (I do it all the time!) And if she refuses to listen to the advice, she may one day turn into a statistic along the hundreds, thousands, of even millions of relationships that fail for similar reasons every year. How's that for uniqueness?

The same with guys who think they are "special" because of whatever insecurities they have. Guys always think they are unique when they write me and say, "Marius, you don't understand...flirting simply does not work for me because I..."

That's when I give them one of my smartass comments to wake them up. =)

Excuse #10: "You Can't Break Down Dating Into a System"

This leads to the last excuse: that you can't just reduce the complex world of dating and relationships into a simple model.

I beg to differ.

In every field or activity, you can find patterns of success and failure. Dating is no different. Everything can be reduced to a set of rules and suggested actions. Just like

knowing how to swing your golf club properly will not ruin your enjoyment of the game, knowing these relationship rules will not make dating or marriage any less exciting for you.
